To see how close water will be to your basement level in the event of a 100 Year Flood, use the following instructions:


A. Find your lot number

Stonewater was developed in 5 phases. Find your Lot Number in the Drawings attached (See Index, Page 2). It could be in Phase 1 or 2 or 3 or 4 or 5. Lot details are shown in the drawings immediately following the Color Coded Drawing for each Phase.

B. How high is your lot compared to 100 year flood level?

If your lot is on the lake, there is a dotted 100 year flood line in the back of your lot - 28.0 indicates 828.0 Feet of Elevation (denotes highest projected level during a 100 year flood)


All lots will show basement level - Number at the back of your building envelope indicates the basement level of your home. In the example below, home on a lake with walkout basement level at 830 Feet is 2 feet above the 100 year flood line of Stoneridge Lake. 838 Feet is the basement floor level for this other home not on a lake. That's 10 feet above the 100 year flood line of Stoneridge Lake.

Thus, for the example homes above, the highest water level during a 100 year (rare) flood would be 828.0 feet, or 3 feet higher than the Normal Waters Edge (825.0 Feet), and 2 feet below the basement floor (830.0 feet) of these walkout homes.


