Cutting Weeds from Beach Lake Bottom-Just off Shore

The following tool can be used for cutting/removing weeds on the bottom of the lake where your beach extends into the lake. It cuts and rips up weeds just off shore for gradual sloping underwater beach areas. To make these areas clear of weeds so that you can wade out into it and not have to wade through weeds. See the before and after pictures.

Steps to remove the weeds:

- 1. Push the Beachroller from the water's edge, underwater, to the end of the Beachroller's handle.
- 2. Slowly pull it and roll it back.
- 3. Move 2 feet to the right or left and repeat.
- 4. <u>Do not pull all the weeds you cut up on shore.</u> Most should roll off and left on the lake bottom. <u>You may have to roll it up on shore occasionally to remove some weeds but most will fall off underwater</u>
- 5. Repeat along your entire shore...wait a week and repeat. There will be less and less to cut each week.
- 6. Most of the weeds will get washed around underwater and disappear. Some will stay and will be loose. You can wade out and use a rake to pull those other weeds out and discard.
- 7. Repeat this 2 times a season and your underwater beach area will stay pretty free of weeds and junk.
- 8. Note: This will not prevent lake weeds from elsewhere on the lake from washing up on your shore.
